#### LIFE

- 1. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: infants; born alive; (SB 1600) Extends protections to all infants born alive and holds accountable health professionals who fail to provide these children with needed care. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 32-26-2. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 6, 2023.*
- 2. CAP Action-OPPOSED: abortion ban; repeal (HB 2677) Repeals Arizona law prohibiting abortion except to save the mother's life. Passed House 32-28. Passed Senate 16-14. Signed by Gov. Hobbs May 2, 2024.

#### MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

- 3. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: pronouns; school policies (SB 1001) Requires written parental consent for school personnel to use a name or pronoun that is contrary to the student's biological sex. Protects conscience rights of school personnel from being forced to call students by a name or pronoun that does not coincide with the student's biological sex. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs May 19, 2023.
- 4. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: public schools; reasonable accommodations (SB 1040) Requires schools to supply reasonable accommodations for students who say they identify as other than their biological sex. Requires access to a single-occupancy facility to anyone who is unwilling or unable to use the restroom or locker room of their biological sex. Passed Senate 16-14. Passed House 31-27-1-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 8, 2023.
- 5. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: public schools; showers; reasonable accommodations (SB 1182) A public school shall provide a reasonable accommodation to any person if: the person for any reason is unable to use a multioccupancy shower room designated for the person's sex. Passed Senate 16-14. Passed House 31-28. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April* 23, 2024.
- 6. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: insurance; gender surgeries; documentation; reports (SB1511) Prohibits a health insurer that offers coverage for gender transition services from denying coverage for gender detransition services and requires outlined health care providers that perform gender transition services to provide gender detransition services. Passed Senate 16-12-2. Passed House 31-29. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 18*, 2024.

- 7. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: sex-based terms; laws; rules; regulations (SB 1628) Defines "sex" and helps protect sex-specific spaces for women and girls. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-28. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 16, 2024.*
- 8. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: parental rights; medical records (HB 2183) Requires a health care entity to provide the parent of a minor child with access to any electronic portal and delivery platform for the minor's medical records. Passed House 32-25. Passed Senate 16-12-2. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 2*, 2024.
- 9. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: harmful website content; age verification (HB 2586) Requires pornography websites to conduct a "reasonable age verification method" to prevent minors from accessing harmful content. Passed House 32-27. Passed Senate 16-12-2. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs April 8, 2024.*
- 10. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: scholarships; requirements; foster care students (HB2095) Expands eligibility for educational scholarships and tuition grants to include students in foster care before graduating from high school or obtaining a general equivalency diploma (GED). Passed House 31-27-2. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs May 17, 2024. Measure later adopted as part of 2024 budget compromise.

### **RELIGIOUS FREEDOM**

- 11. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: schools; libraries; explicit materials; classification (SB 1007) Makes it a class 5 felony for any employee or independent contractor within a public school or public library to facilitate access or refer a student to sexually explicit materials. Passed Senate 16-10-4. Passed House 31-21-7. Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 18, 2024.
- 12. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: social credit; discrimination; financial services (SB 1167) Prohibits a financial institution from discriminating in the provision of financial services to a person based on that person's religious or political speech or views. Passed Senate 16-10-4. *Not heard by House.*
- 13. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: employers; vaccines; religious exemption (SB 1250) Requires employers to allow employees to claim a religious exemption from taking the COVID-19 vaccination. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-29. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs March* 30, 2023.

- 14. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: private school students; interscholastic activities (SB 1564) Allows students in small private schools to play sports at their local public school Passed Senate 16-13-1. Failed House 30-28-1-1.
- 15. CAP Action- OPPOSED: Empowerment Scholarship Account Limitations (Budget item amendment) Proposed amendment to limit enrollment in the Empowerment Scholarship Account program. Failed Senate 14-16. Failed House 27-31-1.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

- 16. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: sex trafficking; minors; natural life (SCR 1021) Subject to voter approval, statutorily requires an adult who is convicted of a class 2 felony for any child sex trafficking offense to be sentenced to natural life imprisonment. Passed Senate 20-8-2. Passed House 31-27-2. *No action required by Gov. Hobbs.*
- 17. CAP Action-SUPPORTED: STOs; individual income tax credits (SB 1243) Simplifies the two individual scholarship tax credit programs. Passed Senate 16-13-1. Passed House 31-27-1-1. *Vetoed by Gov. Hobbs June 8*, 2023.
- 18. CAP-Action OPPOSED: FLOOR AMENDMENT school employment; criminal convictions; disclosure (SB 1558) Subjected private schools that accept payment of Arizona Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) monies from a parent or qualified student to additional regulations and annual state audits. Amendment failed Senate 13-15-2.
